


Waterbury Area Transportation Projects


Project Overview

Waterbury – Stowe VT 100 Rehabilitation Project

Location



- Start: Just north of the Waterbury roundabout at US 2 and VT 100
- End: Intersection of VT 100 and Cliff Street (Stowe Safety Complex)
- Approximately 9.5 miles



Purpose and Need



Rehabilitation of VT 100 will lower maintenance and operational costs and increase user safety

- Removal of concrete slabs under asphalt
- Create uniform subbase material for improved longevity of surface conditions
- Create more uniformity in lane and shoulder width
- Improve intersection configurations

Overview of Rehabilitation



- Remove full width of pavement to the depth of concrete slabs
- Remove concrete slabs
- Fill with new subbase material
- Pave roadway



Finished Roadway



- 11' Travel lanes through most locations
- 5' Shoulders through most locations
- Corrected banking
- New and consistent driving surface




Additional Project Features



- Signal improvements in the Town of Waterbury
- New traffic signal at the intersection of VT 100 and Guptil Road
- New sidewalk in the Lower Village of Stowe
- Addition of delineated bike lanes





Construction and Schedule

Waterbury – Stowe VT 100 Rehabilitation Project

Construction Activities



- Construction Start: Mid-April (weather dependent)
- Location Start: Waterbury, working north
 - Pavement and concrete will be removed and replaced in segments
 - During removal of concrete slabs, drainage features will be repaired and/or replaced
- Construction Timing: 7 PM - 6 AM, Sunday – Thursday
 - All lane closures are restricted to nighttime activities
 - Two-way traffic will be maintained during daytime hours
- Construction End: Intersection with Cliff Street (Stowe Safety Complex)
